Working in the ReStores

Our intent is to establish a pleasant and enjoyable but productive atmosphere while you are working at the ReStores. Please adhere to all ReStore and Safety guidelines.

Before your first day at the Restore, you must complete the "ReStore Safety and Loss Control for Volunteers" course either online or at the administrative office.

At the ReStore

- Please <u>sign in</u> when you come in each day and <u>sign</u>
 <u>out</u> when you leave. It is <u>your</u> responsibility to write legibly or you may not get proper credit for your time.
- If you leave the property for any reason you must sign out.
- Please wear appropriate clothing. Graphic shirts or hats, inappropriate length shorts or revealing tops are not acceptable. Open toed shoes, sandals and crocs are not allowed.



And work...

- Please keep cell phone use to a minimum. You are not here to chat or text. Continuous use of your cell phone will not be tolerated.
- Everyone needs to stay busy. If you don't have anything to do, ask a staff member. There is always something to do. If we can't find something for you to do, you will be asked to leave.
- You are not here to shop. Please shop after you have completed your hours. EVERYTHING must be paid for BEFORE it leaves the store! Please don't ask for a discount, the money spent in the store helps fund your Habitat house.

- Drinks We happily supply bottled water to those working in sometimes unfavorable conditions.
- Smoking is only permitted out back in the designated smoking areas.
- If you are assigned a task that you are incapable of performing, please inform a staff member immediately.

Before you Start



- Before you can start your "Sweat Equity" hours for Construction you must complete the following trainings either on-line or at our administrative office:
 - Volunteering on a Habitat for Humanity Jobsite (required for anyone on our jobsites)
 - Portable Power Tool Safety (required for anyone ready, willing and able to use power tools)
 - Directions to access the trainings on-line is on our website- www.habitatcc.org
 - To schedule training at the administrative office call 352-563-2744 to schedule an appointment.



Construction Practices



- We work on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays from 8am-12pm.
- Our goal is not only to get the scope of work completed but also train you, the homeowner, about the homes we build so that you can maintain your home in an effective and timely fashion.
- We have a Construction Team on site to assist with each phases of the Construction process.
- This Team is composed of a Construction Manager and two Construction Site Leaders. Please follow their instructions carefully because they are the safety authority on the jobsites.

If you have any questions other than the tasks being completed for the day, please schedule an appointment with me or the office to answer the questions. Remember, our goal is to finish the task for the day so that the construction build can remain on schedule.

Jobsite Attire

Habitat provides each homeowner and volunteer with a Habitat t-shirt. Please be sure to wear it when attending the jobsite. No tank tops, please. Additionally, you must wear closed toe shoes. No crocks, please. There are different elevations and materials on the jobsite so protecting your feet is a must.







Weekly Schedule

A Weekly Schedule is sent to homeowners as well as volunteers.

The Weekly Schedule includes the jobsite addresses where you are scheduled to participate. You will be listed as "Partner Families "on the Weekly Schedule. In addition, the Weekly Schedule is posted at our website, <u>www.habitatcc.org</u>.

If "Partner Families" is not listed for a particular day or jobsite, Homeowners will be instructed to participate at one of the Restores.

Be a Team member/builder



As a Homeowner, you are part of the Construction Team and your responsibility to participate at the jobsite is expected. Please be an encourager at the jobsite.

Appreciate other Volunteers - Say "Thank you" often

Our Volunteers are a very integral part of our organization. We need our Volunteers to help us build these homes. Please take the time to say thank you to them and say it often. At the end of the program, you get a beautiful home, take the time to thank them.

Do not solicit Habitat Volunteers to donate hours for you

You are encouraged to recruit your family members and friends to assist you with your Construction hours. Please discuss recruitment with your Mentor to assure that these friends and family members have been vetted properly before visiting the jobsite.

You should not recruit our volunteers to donate hours for you. However, a Volunteer can donate their hours to you.
